



PROJECT LIFESAVER of CHISAGO COUNTY



The Chisago County Sheriff's Office had partnered with Project Lifesaver International. This program is "Dedicated to Bringing Loved Ones Home".

The program is for persons with debilitating conditions that would cause them to wander, such as Alzheimer's Disease, Autism, Stroke, Brain Injuries and Down Syndrome. These conditions can inhibit the person's ability communicate to others that they are lost, or may not know they are lost.

A person enrolled in the program wears a wrist watch sized bracelet that can be either on the wrist or ankle. This device houses a transmitter that sends a signal allowing searchers to track them.
