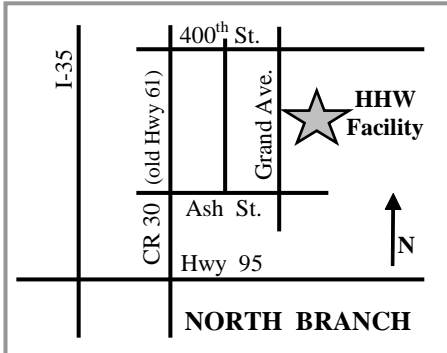

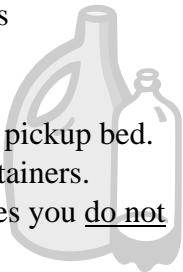

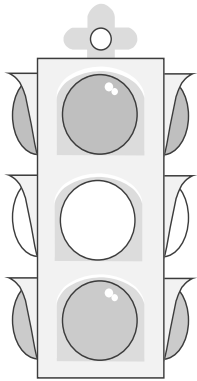

STOP!

Don't Throw Your Household Chemicals In The Trash!

Bring unwanted household chemicals to the **Chisago County Household Hazardous Waste Facility (HHWF)** for disposal.

The program is open to:

- **Residents of Chisago County** and is funded by the Waste Management Fee. All you need to participate is proof of County residency, so bring ID.
- **Chisago County residents may also use the Washington County facility.** For information call (651) 275-7475.
- **Residents of Washington County** may use the Chisago County Facility by way of a reciprocity agreement.
- **Residents of Isanti County** may participate by voucher, call Isanti Zoning at (763) 689-5165 to request yours, voucher **MUST** accompany waste at time of disposal.
- **Pine, Kanabec, and Mille Lacs County residents** may participate with **\$70 minimum** charge due at time of drop off and **must call for an appointment** (651) 213-8920#5.
- **Pine County** has a seasonal facility. Call (320) 591-1678 for more info.

Household Hazardous Waste Program

ITEMS ACCEPTED

Max size 5 gal. **Don't mix products!**

Automotive/Petroleum Products:

Antifreeze, brake fluid, charcoal lighter fluid, gasoline, kerosene, oil & oil filters, power steering & transmission fluid, cleaners, etc...

Home Improvement Products:

Adhesive, driveway sealer, paints, paint stripper and thinner, roofing tar, rust remover, solvent, stain, varnish, wood preservative, aerosols ...

Batteries - Sort into:

- * Rechargeable Ni-Cd & Ni-MH
- * Button
- * Lithium (must clear-tape the ends)
- * Sealed Lead Acid <11 lbs. (must tape terminals)

*** NO VEHICLE BATTERIES!**

Household Cleaners:

Cleaning products, drain cleaner, metal polish, oven cleaner, spot remover, bleach, ammonia...

Lawn & Garden Chemicals:

Fertilizer with weed killer, flea killer, herbicides, mothballs, pesticides...

Miscellaneous items:

Acids/bases, ammunition, cell phones, fire extinguishers, LED & fluorescent bulbs, inkjet cartridges, holiday lights, mercury, PCB ballasts, pool chemicals, propane cylinders<20#...

Sharps:

Self-serve. Drop in red bin at HHWF.

Appliances, Electronics, Tires & Mattresses:

Alkaline Batteries (& Zinc Carbon):

Dispose of in trash.

Vehicle Batteries:

Automotive, marine, motorcycle, lawn tractor, etc., RETURN for free to any MN business that sells them.

Construction/Remodeling Debris:

Call your local garbage hauler or DKV Demolition Landfill at (320) 358-4911.

Trash/Empty Containers:

Throw in your trash: alkaline batteries, empty containers, fertilizer **without** weed killer, empty dried out paint cans with lids removed, smoke/carbon monoxide detectors...

Pharmaceutical Drop Boxes:

Sheriff's Offices: Center City & Rush City; Police Departments: North Branch, Wyoming & Lindstrom.
